
Safe Church Policy

In order to adopt the Child Safe standards presented by the government, we must commit to.....



- 1. Provide spaces, programs and relationships that are safe for our young people
- 2. A thorough process to screen, induct and resource our staff and volunteers
- 3. Clear process for dealing with conflict and complaints
- 4. Safe physical and on-line environments
- 5. Appropriate risk management
- 6. That our affiliated entities also comply
- 7. Diligent record keeping about 45 years and protecting the confidentiality of those records and storing safely.
- 8. Being accountable to the Baptist Association and Government authorities
